



Important Rider Information

YARTS tickets are purchased directly from YARTS bus drivers. Reservations are neither sought or accepted.

All YARTS fares to Yosemite include park gate fees.

YARTS buses are equipped to accept wheel chairs.

Please wait a minimum of 15 minutes beyond time shown on schedule. Times shown indicate departures, but unexpected delays may occur.

SOD - Stop On Demand: Stops only when requested by a passenger, or when a passenger is waiting at the stop location.

YARTS provides convenient connections with Yosemite Park shuttles and tours in Yosemite Valley, including the free shuttle that stops at each YARTS stop inside the park. There is also a free shuttle available in Tuolumne Meadows that has many trail heads as stops.

Round trip ticket holders board first in Yosemite Valley, but should plan to be at the bus stop at least 10-15 minutes ahead of the departure time.

YARTS Policy Regarding Stopping at Unscheduled Locations

Throughout the year, but particularly during the summer hiking season, we get a lot of questions about having YARTS buses make stops at locations, like trailheads, that are not listed on the established schedule.

The following is intended to clarify YARTS policy about this:

YARTS does not make stops to pick passengers up at unscheduled locations.

YARTS buses can make unscheduled stops to allow riders to exit the bus **if**:

The stop is made on the same side of the road that is the direction of travel.

There is sufficient room for the get the bus entirely off the roadway.

There is sufficient flat ground outside the bus door for passengers and the driver to exit the bus safely and for the retrieval of luggage or backpacks from the bus luggage compartment.

Our drivers are charged with not only the safety of our passengers, but also with the safety of others using the roadway. They alone make the decision about whether a stop can be made safely or not. The driver is the Captain of the Ship, so to speak, and their decision is final.

There is a free shuttle service in the Tuolumne Meadows area that runs to a number of the popular trailheads in that area. YARTS riders are encouraged to use the shuttle to reach locations that YARTS cannot service safely.
