- ❖ YARTS will provide free transportation on YARTS (in the form of redeemable vouchers) to students enrolled in a college or university beginning September 1 2024, through May 31, 2026, or until funding for this project has been exhausted, whichever comes first. Proof of enrollment is required.
- **❖** YARTS buses are ADA accessible.

- Applicant must be a resident of Merced or Mariposa County to be eligible for a 31-day pass.
- All 31-day pass applicants must submit proof of residency (government issued identification, utility bill, etc.) with proof of enrollment in a college or university.
- Eligible participants will be emailed a voucher/31-day pass that can be used to make a reservation online, via the YARTS website, www.YARTS.com.
- Vouchers will not be accepted if presented on the bus please use the YARTS reservation system to reserve your seat.
- Each voucher code may only be used once and only one voucher code may be used per transaction.
- Ticket vouchers and 31-day passes will be distributed based on available funding and in the order of which they are received.
- Please see the YARTS Refund Policy for cancellation requirements.
- Cancellations will not be provided a monetary refund.
- ❖ YARTS is not liable for lost or stolen vouchers and/or 31-day passes.
